

Geneva to Monaco: A Grand Tour in the Mercedes-AMG G 500

Leaving the city behind, the motorway follows the northern shore of Lake Geneva before crossing into France towards Annecy. After several hours on the road, the charming Provençal town of Valence provides the perfect excuse for a leisurely lunch.

The afternoon journey continues south along the Rhône Valley before the scent of pine forests gives way to Mediterranean air. Gradually, the landscape opens towards the Côte d'Azur, where winding coastal roads and panoramic sea views announce your arrival on one of Europe's most glamorous coastlines.



Few arrivals compare with driving into Monaco as the late afternoon sun reflects from the façades of Monte Carlo. The G 500, with its timeless design and understated presence, feels perfectly suited to the surroundings. Pulling onto the Place du Casino, surrounded by the Belle Époque architecture of the Casino de Monte-Carlo and the legendary Hôtel de Paris, is an experience that has captivated motorists for generations.

As evening falls, Monaco reveals its unique atmosphere. Luxury yachts fill Port Hercule, cafés spill onto elegant terraces, and the illuminated Casino Square becomes a showcase of automotive excellence from every corner of the world.

The journey from Geneva to Monaco covers approximately 600 kilometres and can comfortably be completed in a day, although allowing time for leisurely stops transforms a simple transfer into one of Europe's great road trips.
